

BOISE COMICS ARTS FESTIVAL 2024 – COSPLAY CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES

BY REGISTERING FOR THIS CONTEST, YOU FULLY AND UNCONDITIONALLY AGREE TO COMPLY WITH ALL THE RULES AND REGULATIONS BELOW. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH ANY OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS, DO NOT REGISTER FOR THIS CONTEST AND DO NOT SUBMIT AN ENTRY.

I. Contest Description and Overview

The Boise Comic Arts Festival 2024 is an annual event hosted by the Boise Public Library to celebrate the literary medium of comics and graphic novels. The Cosplay Contest will be live and is your chance to show off your costume making skills and creativity. Your costume could win you fame, glory, and of course – prizes!

II. Overview

All Contest entries, information, questions, or comments shall be directed to the Contest Administrators. No purchase, payment, or donation of any kind is necessary to enter to win; a purchase, payment, or donation will not increase the chance of winning.

III. Agreement to the Official Rules

By entering this contest, you indicate your full and unconditional agreement to all the Official Rules as set forth herein and to the Contest Administrator's (defined below) decisions, which shall be final and binding. Failure to accept these Official Rules prohibits participation in this Contest, voids any participation in this Contest, and renders any submission ineligible for an award under this Contest. You additionally fully and unconditionally agree that the City of Boise is hereby completely released of all liability in relation to your participation in this Contest.

IV. Contest Sponsors and Contest Administrators

- A. The Contest is sponsored by the City of Boise, Library Department (715 S. Capitol Blvd., Boise, Idaho, 83702) ("Sponsor").
- B. A panel of qualified judges ("Judges") comprised of members of the Boise Comic Arts Festival Team and/or individuals appointed by the Boise Comic Arts Festival Team, in their absolute and sole discretion, shall judge all Contest entries and determine the winner of this Contest. The City reserves the right to select substitute judges or modify the judging panel at any time and for any reason.
- C. The Sponsor and Judges (collectively the "Contest Administrators") shall work in conjunction to administer this Contest. Contest Administrators have full authority to enforce any and all rules and regulations set forth herein.

V. Eligibility

- A. Unless otherwise provided for by the Contest Rules and Regulations, you are eligible to enter if you meet all of the following requirements at the time of entry:

1. You are at least 18 years of age as of August 24, 2024, or, if you are a minor, your parent or guardian has agreed to your entry in this Contest; and
 2. You have submitted your contest entry, including all required information, by the required date and time for submission; and
 3. You are NOT an employee, intern, or volunteer with the City of Boise or any of its departments, offices, or subdivisions; and
 4. You are NOT an immediate family member of (parent, sibling, spouse/domestic partner, child) any person employed with the City of Boise or any of its departments, offices, or subdivisions; and
 5. You are not involved in any part of the execution or administration of this Contest.
- B. The Sponsor reserves the right to limit or restrict, upon notice, participation in the Contest to any person at any time for any reason in its sole discretion or the discretion of the Contest Administrators.
- C. Contest participants are responsible for any costs or expenses associated with preparing and submitting their Contest entry.

VI. Contest Period

- A. The Contest begins at 12:00:00 United States Mountain Time (“MT”) on July 29, 2024 and ends at 18:00:00 MT on, August 24, 2024. The Contest Administrators’ clock is the official time keeping device for this Contest. Late Contest Entries submitted shall be automatically disqualified.
- B. The Contest Administrators reserve the right in their sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the Contest and these Rules and Regulations for any reason.

VII. Representations and Warranties

- A. By Participating in this Contest, each participant hereby warrants and represents that any contest entry submitted:
1. Is complete, accurate and truthful;
 2. Is original work created by the entrant;
 3. Does not violate any law, statute, ordinance, or regulation;
 4. Does not infringe or violate any rights of any third-party or entity, including, without limitation, patent, copyright, trademark, trade secret, defamation, privacy, publicity, false-light, misappropriation, confidentiality, or any other contractual rights;
 5. Is not defamatory, libelous, pornographic, or obscene;
 6. Does not contain, depict, include, discuss or involve, without limitation, nudity, alcohol, illicit drugs, smoking, explicit or graphic sexual activity, sexual innuendo, vulgar or offensive language or symbols, derogatory characterization of any ethnic, racial, sexual, religious or other groups, personal information, commercial messages or solicitations, clothing or symbols related to criminal groups (e.g. gangs), or any other comment or behavior that is or could be considered inappropriate, unsuitable, or offensive by the Contest Administrators in their sole and absolute discretion.

- B. Any entry that the Contest Administrators deem in their sole and absolute discretion to violate the terms and conditions set forth in the Rules is subject to disqualification. The Contest Administrators reserve the right, at any time and for any reason, to request an entrant to modify, edit, or resubmit their entry to ensure that the entry post complies with these Rules, or for any other reason.
- C. Each Participant agrees to release and hold harmless the Sponsor, Contest Administrators, and any other organizations responsible for sponsoring, fulfilling, administering, advertising or promoting the Contest, and all their respective officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives (collectively, the "Released Parties") from and against any and all claims, expenses and liabilities. These claims, expenses and liabilities include, but are not limited to, negligence and damages of any kind to persons and property, defamation, slander, libel, violation of right of publicity, infringement of trademark, copyright or other intellectual property rights, property damage, or death or personal injury arising out of or relating to a Contest submission, creation of an entry or submission for an entry, participation in the Contest, acceptance or use or misuse of prize, and/or the broadcast, transmission or use of the entry. The Released Parties shall be held harmless by any participant in the event it is subsequently discovered that such participant departed from or did not fully comply with any of these Rules.
- D. Released Parties are not responsible for: 1) any incorrect or inaccurate information; 2) for any incomplete, failed, or delayed transmission of any registration, application or submissions due to the internet, including, but not limited to interruption or delays caused by equipment or software malfunctions or other technical problems; 3) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the entry process or the Contest; 4) technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest or processing of entries; or 5) any injury or damage to persons or property that may be caused directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from participation in the Contest or receipt or use or misuse of any prize.
- E. No entry submission will be received or held "in confidence" and under no circumstances will any Submission create a confidential relationship or obligation of secrecy between participants and the Sponsor, Contest Administrators, Judges, other participants, or any other party.
- F. Sponsors make no warranties, express or implied, for the prize.

VIII. General Standards for Entries

- A. There are four (4) categories for this contest: Kids (ages 0-12 years); Teens (ages 12-18 years); Adults (ages 18 years and up), and Group (all ages).
- B. To be eligible for judging, all Contest entries must meet all the following general standards:
 - 1. All contest entries must include the contest category of the entry, the name of the contestant, the contestant's age, and the contestant's mailing address, phone number, and email address; and

2. If the contest participant is a minor, the contest entry must also include the name of the participant's parent or guardian who is giving permission to the minor to participate in the Contest and age of the minor; and
 3. If required, on the entry form, answer all questions about the participant's contest entry; and
 4. All contest entries, including required model release forms, must be submitted to the contest entry site located online at www.boisepubliclibrary.org/bcaf, Or in person the day of the contests
 5. You must comply with all Boise Public Library's Code of Conduct as set forth here - <https://tinyurl.com/munb2cn2>;and
 6. You must comply with all Contest Rules and Regulations set forth herein; and
 7. All contest entries must be submitted between 12:00:00 MT on July 29, 2024, and no later than 18:00:00 MT on August 24, 2024.
- C. All Participants may only enter the individual contests once, but may also enter the Group contest.
- D. All entries must include a fully completed and signed model release form for the participant. **Failure to provide a fully completed and signed model release form will result in automatic disqualification of such entry in the Contest.**
- E. By submitting an entry, you agree that all submitted information complies with all the conditions state in these Rules.
- F. The following rules apply to Group entries:
1. A group must consist of a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 6 participants.
 2. All group members must be present during the performance and judging.
 3. Groups must register under a group name and provide the names, ages, and contact information of all members.
 4. A single-entry form must be submitted for the entire group.
 5. Groups must perform a skit or presentation lasting no more than 3 minutes.

IX. Judging and Selection of a Winner

- A. Selection of the 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place prizes shall be conducted by the panel of Judges on August 24, 2024.
- B. Entries shall be judged based on the following criteria:
1. Kids Contest – 5 points per category:
 1. Creativity – the showcasing of original elements, style, and imaginative characters, costumes, and props conveyed in the entry.
 2. Design and Detail – detail, material usage, construction technique.
 3. Stage Presence – ability of a contestant to capture and command the attention of an audience.
 2. Teen and Adult Contests – 5 points per category:
 1. Craftsmanship/Construction - Sewing detail, material usage, construction technique.
 2. Accuracy/Originality – the level of recognizable characterizations demonstrated through the quality and detail of the costume, props, and

representation of characters shown in the entry. Alternately, for original characters, the forethought, planning, creativity, and design that went into the creation of the cosplay.

3. Stage Presence – ability of a contestant to capture and command the attention of an audience.
3. Group Contest – 5 points per category:
 1. Craftsmanship/Construction - Quality of the costumes, material usage, and construction techniques.
 2. Accuracy/Originality - Faithfulness to the characters or creativity and design for original characters.
 3. Stage Presence - Ability to capture and command the audience's attention as a cohesive unit.
 4. Group Coordination - How well the group works together to present a unified performance.
- C. Contestants should note that the quality of the presentation of the character being depicted and the detail and effort spent on creating the costume and props will overall improve the chance of winning. Additional weight will be given to handmade costumes over purchased ones.
- D. Failure to comply with all Contest Rules and the entry criteria shall result in disqualification of entry.
- E. All scoring and evaluation shall be determined by the Judges in their sole and absolute discretion.
- F. All decisions of the Judges are final and binding.
- G. The Judges in their sole discretion will review all eligible final entries submitted during the contest period and select the winner based on the judging criteria above.

X. Notification and Requirements of Potential Winner

- A. The Sponsor shall announce the winners and award prizes at the event.
- B. The Contest Administrators shall announce the winners on the City's websites and/or social media channels by August 26, 2024.

XI. Prizes

- A. For each category of this contest there shall be awarded a 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place prize. These prizes shall be gift certificates provided by the Library, and/or stores such as: The Reveal, Crazy Neighbor, Joann's, and Michaels, Re-POP.
- B. There shall be only three (3) prizes awarded to the winners of each category of this Contest in gift in the value amounts as follows:

- C. Prizes awarded are not redeemable for cash. No prize is transferable. No substitution for a prize will be made at the request of a winner. The Contest Administrators reserve the right to substitute a prize of similar value.
- D. Each winner is solely responsible for all taxes or fees that may be incurred. Each winner is required to provide picture identification which includes proof of age to claim a prize.

XII. Publicity and Personal Information

Acceptance of any prize constitutes permission for Contest Administrators to exploit and use the winning Participant's name, biographical information, statements, photographs, likeness, and voice online, in print or in any other media, in connection with this Contest, without compensation or payment, except where prohibited by law.

XIII. General Conditions

- A. Force Majeure. The Contest Administrators reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Contest, or any part thereof, if any fraud, technical failures, virus, bug, bot, catastrophic event or any other unforeseen or unexpected event occurs that cannot be reasonably anticipated or controlled and would affect the fairness and/or integrity of this Contest.
- B. Any participant who attempts to compromise the integrity or the legitimate operation of this Contest, or Contest Administrators have reason to believe have compromised the integrity or legitimate operation of this Contest by cheating, hacking, engaging in unfair playing practices towards other participants, Sponsors, or Contest Administrators (including but not limited to harassing, abusing, threatening behavior), or committing fraud in any way will be automatically disqualified and banned from participating in all future Contests and may be liable for damages to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- C. Governing Law. The Contest and the rights and obligations of all participants and submissions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of Idaho without regard to the principles of conflicts in laws. The Idaho courts (state and federal) have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute or controversy arising out of or related to these Contest Rules and all participants hereby agree to waive any objections to jurisdiction or venue in those courts and submit to the jurisdiction of those courts.
- D. Severability. If any provision of these Rules should be held to be void, invalid, unenforceable, or illegal by a proper legal authority, the validity and enforceability of the other provisions shall not be affected.
